PLEASE NOTE: As per Georgia High School Rodeo's instructions we will be filling our slots for the performances first. Each state will be able to put two (2) contestants per event per performance and four (4) contestants per event in Sunday's slack. The remainder will be placed in Friday and Saturday's slack.

PLEASE NOTE - We will be doing first call - first placed during our call in EVEN with the preferred call in. If an event has been filled or is not available when you call in, even if you had planned to use your preferred, you will have to make another choice.

This rodeo is a multi – state rodeo. Florida will compete and rodeo along side other states. We will be keeping state points separately for each event for our contestants. This rodeo does count for your end of the year points. Although we will be competing as a state and as an individual for Perry awards, you will only be competing for Florida points with other Florida contestants.

CONTESTANT JACKPOT : Perry will be having one big jackpot, per event, for the weekend with all the states combined. The fee is \$10. with all but \$1. going into the jackpot. Events will pay one place for every four entries through 20th place. All jackpot entries must be made with the state call-in. No jackpot entries will be taken at the rodeo Official results will be

available on the GHSRA website the week after the rodeo, then e-mailed to the state secretaries. Checks will be mailed to each state by the week of November 16th, 2009. Florida will not have a separate jackpot.

ORDER OF EVENTS – Bareback, Goat Tying, Saddle Bronc, Tie-Down Roping, Breakaway Roping, Steer Wrestling, Barrel Racing, Team Roping, Pole Bending and Bull Riding.

CHURCH SERVICE – There will be a church service held on Sunday, 12:00 noon at the arena.

GRAND ENTRY – We will be having a grand entry at all three performances, and a \$250.00 award will be given to the state with the best showing, also a \$250.00 Spirit Award will be given. The themes for the grand entries are FRIDAY – PINK NIGHT; SATURDAY – STATE CHOICE (Our Florida Queen will let us know what we are doing for the grand entries); SUNDAY – RED, WHITE & BLUE. Please bring something appropriate for these grand entries, and remember, if you have a horse on the rodeo grounds and it is safe for you to ride, you are required to ride in the grand entry, and rough stock riders will stand near the bucking chutes. Please, air horns are not allowed in Reeves Arena.

SPECIAL GROUND RULES – There are some special ground rules particular to the Southeastern Showdown. The Rules are as follows.

1. Thirty (30) second time limits will be in effect for all times events.
2. In all roping events, the one loop rule will be in effect.
3. Western attire is required at all times in Reeves Arena along with your back number.

AWARDS – Awards will be given out after Sunday performance. Belt Buckles will be given to the winners of each event, as well as All-Around Cowboy and Cowgirl. Plaques will be given to second through fourth place finishers.

ADMISSION – Weekend admission passes and daily admission passes will be available. Advance weekend admission through your state secretary will be discounted.

Admission at door:

Weekend: Adults and children over 14 - \$18.00 Children under 14, free.

Daily: Adults and children over 14 - \$8.00 Children under 14, free

Contestant: Free with back number

ADVANCE ADMISSION FOR WEEKEND: \$15.00 (see attached order form)

HORSE STALLS – There are over 600 covered, nice and strong individual horse stalls. Shavings are NOT provided. Shavings are for sale at the Fairgrounds or you may bring your own. EACH CONTESTANT MUST PUT THEIR HORSE OR HORSES IN A STALL WITH ONLY ONE HORSE PER STALL. NO HORSES CAN BE TIED TO TRAILERS AND NO PENS CAN BE SET UP AT TRAILERS. THIS IS AN AGRICENTER RULE. (Stalls must be ordered on the attached order form)

RV HOOK-UPS – There are plenty of campsites with full hook-up. Arrange for any campsites directly with the Georgia National Fairgrounds and Agricenter to make your reservations. Your reservation can be made by calling 1-478-988-6557 or through their website, www.

gnfa.com. Cost is \$25.00 per night. No generators please – you must use the facilities if you are camped on the grounds.

PLEASE NOTE: You will not be permitted admittance to the fairgrounds before 12:00 noon on Friday, November 6th.

The Agricenter has a security gate with personnel on duty 24 hours. In an emergency you can call 1-478-988-6557. They are there only for assistance and have no connections with the rodeo.

DIRECTIONS TO RODEO – Take I-75 to exit 135, Georgia National Fairgrounds and Agricenter, Perry, Georgia. Go east on Larry Walker Parkway, approximately 1 mile to the EAST GATE and proceed to the security gate.
